

CFECapital announces the update of the tariffs for the public service of transmission of electricity in Mexico for 2021, which were approved by the Energy Regulatory Commission based on the current methodology. The tariffs for the public service of transmission of electricity had an average increase of 2.04%. The new tariffs will be valid until the new methodology is approved.

Mexico City, Mexico, December 31, 2020.- CFECAPITAL, S. DE R.L. DE C.V., manager of CFE Fibra E,¹ the first investment trust in energy and infrastructure specialized in the energy sector in Mexico reports the following to the investors:

On December 17^{th} , 2020 the Government Body of the Energy Regulatory Commission (CRE) celebrated an ordinary session in which the Agreement A/045/2020² was approved, in this, it was determined to continue the extension of the validity of the initial tariff period for the public service of transmission of electricity, updating the costs of the required income defined in the agreement A/045/2015. The new tariffs approved will be valid from January 1 to December 31, 2021 or until the new tariff methodology is approved, in which case the begging of the new tariff period must be defined.

The tariffs for interconnected generators decreased in average 1.37% compared with 2020 rates, while transmission rates for supply services to the consumers had an increase of 3.49%. In the following days *CFE Transmisión* will publish the new tariffs in the Official Journal of the Federation.

CFECapital will publish a note on its website explaining the assumptions made by the CRE for this change, as well as the final figures for each rate bracket, once the excel report is published by the CRE.
