

Designation of the new commissioners of the Energy Regulatory Commission (CRE for its name in Spanish).

Mexico City, Mexico, April 04 2019.- Today, the president of Mexico, Andres Manuel Lopez Obrador, has designated the new commissioners of CRE. This was according to the article 6 of the Law of Coordinated Energy Regulators² that establishes that once the Senate has rejected a group of candidates sent by the president for the second time, corresponds to him the responsibility to appoint the new commissioner. The new commissioners are:

- Luis Linares Zapata has Bachelor degree in business and applied economics and a Master on both topics from the University of Pennsylvania. He has worked in Pemex as an advisor to the policy development and social development areas. In addition, he was an advisor to the Senate for the Energy Reform, currently he is a researcher and professor at several private and public institutions.
- Normal Leticia Campos Aragón has Bachelor degree in Economics and a Master in Latin-American studies from Universidad Nacional Autonóma de México (UNAM) and a PhD in Social Sciences. She has been dedicated to teaching and research at UNAM, mostly about industrial policy, energy, economic history, environment and development.
- José Alberto Celestinos Issacs is Chemical Engineer from UNAM. He is an
 expert in refining, was Executive Advisor at the General Direction of Pemex, was
 involved in the construction of three refineries and currently is the General Director
 of Celestinos consulting firm.
- Guadalupe Escalante Benítez is an Industrial Chemical Engineer from Instituto Politécnico Nacional (IPN) and has a Master on Business Administration from Universidad de las Américas Puebla. She has worked in planning at Pemex Petroquímica and was also superintendent of planning and evaluation in the same subsidiary.

With these designations, the new Government Body of CRE is completed, it also composed by Guillermo García Alcocer (President Commissioner), Luis Guillermo Pineda Bernal and Guillermo Zúñiga Marínez.
