CFECapital informs about the update of the Tariffs for the Public Electricity Transmission service in Mexico for the year 2024, approved by the Energy Regulatory Commission (CRE) and published in the Resolution A/069/2023

Mexico City, December 21st, 2023.- CFECapital, S. de R.L. de C.V., in its capacity as Administrator of CFE Fibra E,¹ the First Energy and Infrastructure Investment Trust specialized in the energy sector in Mexico informs the following to its investing public:

On December 13th, 2023, in an extraordinary session, the Governing Body of the Energy Regulatory Commission (CRE), issued Resolution A/069/2023,² in which they informed the Regulated Tariffs of the Public Electric Power Transmission Service applicable from January 1st to December 31st, 2024, are the following:

1. It is the holder of one or more permits to generate electricity in Power Plants, or the holder of a Market Participant contract that represents these plants in the MEM or, with the authorization of the Commission, the Power Plants located in abroad.

2. They are facilities and equipment that, at a specific site, allow an end user to receive the electrical supply. The Load Centers will be determined at the point of measurement of the supplied energy.

The Energy Regulatory Commission determined for CFE Transmission a **Required Income (IR)** for the year 2024 of \$80,681 million pesos, 6.23% higher than the IR of the previous year. Regarding the **projections of electric power for 2024**, that is, the energy injected and withdrawn from the National Transmission Grid that were used to calculate the tariffs present a growth rate of 5.36% and 5.61%, respectively, with respect to the projections used in 2023 transmission tariffs.

It is important to highlight that, for the determination of the Regulated Tariffs of the Public Electric Energy Transmission Service 2024, the Energy Regulatory Commission applied the methodology to determine the calculation and adjustment of the Regulated Tariffs issued in the General Administrative Provisions (DACG) through Resolution A/044/2022, which were published in the Official Gazette of the Federation on March 31st, 2023.
