

CFE Capital Announces the Appointment of a Key Officer

Today, the XII Session of the Conflict Committee of the Irrevocable Trust CIB/2919 was held, during which the Independent Members unanimously approved the appointment of Iván Cajeme Villarreal Camero as a Key Officer, recognizing him as the new General Director of CFE Capital, S. de R.L. de C.V., replacing Carmen Serdán Banda.

Cajeme Villarreal has over 13 years of experience in Mexico's financial, energy, and transportation sectors. His previous positions include Director of Planning and Budget at Grupo Protexa, Chief Economist at the Ministry of Finance and Public Credit, Head of the Non-Tax Revenue Policy Unit at the same institution, and General Director of Market Analysis and Oversight at the Ministry of Energy, among others.

Villarreal has also served on the Strategy and Investment Committees of Petróleos Mexicanos (Pemex) and the Federal Electricity Commission (CFE), as well as on the Boards of Directors of the National Energy Control Center (CENACE).

Cajeme Villarreal holds a degree in economics from the Autonomous University of Nuevo León, El Colegio de México, and the University of Chicago, and was a Visiting Researcher at Yale University.

CFE Capital, S. de R.L. de C.V., reiterates to its investors the key role that CFE Fibra E plays a source of financing for strategic projects aimed at strengthening the CFE, expanding electric infrastructure and contributing to Mexico's economic development.
