

CFE Capital Reports on the Determination of Regulated Rates for Public Electricity Transmission Service in Mexico, applicable from January 1st to December 31st, 2025, approved by the Energy Regulatory Commission (CRE) and Published in Agreement A/154/2024

Mexico City, January 7th, 2024, CFE Capital, S. de R.L. de C.V., in its capacity as Administrator of CFE Fibra E, the First Energy and Infrastructure Investment Trust specializing in the energy sector in Mexico, informs its investor audience as follows:

On December 13th, 2024, in an ordinary session, the Governing Body of the Energy Regulatory Commission (CRE) issued Agreement A/154/2024, in which they announced that the Regulated Rates for the Public Electricity Transmission Service, applicable from January 1st to December 31st, 2025, are as follows:

The Energy Regulatory Commission has determined a **Required Income (RI) for CFE Transmisión for the year 2025** of \$83,813 million pesos, **3.9% higher** than the RI for the previous year. Regarding the **projections for electrical energy in 2025**, specifically the electricity injected and withdrawn from the National Transmission Network (RNT by its initials in Spanish), they present a growth rate of **1.5%** and **1.2%**, respectively, compared to the projections used in the 2024 transmission tariffs.

It is important to highlight that, for determining of the 2025 Regulated Rates for the Public Electricity Transmission Service, the Energy Regulatory Commission applied the methodology for calculating and adjusting the Regulated Tariffs issued in the General Administrative Provisions (DACG) through Agreement A/044/2022, which were published in the Official Federal Gazette on March 31st, 2023.

The Energy Regulatory Commission will issue complementary information, and based on that, CFECapital will publish an additional note on its website with the most relevant aspects of the 2025 transmission tariffs.
