

## CFE Capital reports on the update of regulated fees for the Public Electricity Transmission Service in Mexico applicable from January 1 to December 31, 2026.

**Mexico City, February 12, 2026.**- CFE Capital, S. de R.L. de C.V., in its capacity as Administrator of the CFE Fibra E Trust, informs that the Relevant Event published on January 30, 2026 is hereby fully revoked and rendered without effect.

Likewise, it is informed that, on February 11, 2026, the update of the fees that will be applied by the Federal Electricity Commission (*Comisión Federal de Electricidad*) for the Public Electricity Transmission Service for the period from January 1 to December 31 was published in the Official Gazette of the Federation (*Diario Oficial de la Federación*).

This update is issued in accordance with the General Administrative Provisions establishing the Methodology to determine the calculation and adjustment of the regulated fees for the Public Electricity Transmission Service, approved by the Technical Committee of the National Energy Commission through Agreement No. CT/7.SE/3-2025, and published in the Official Gazette of the Federation on November 26, 2025.

Notes: The above fees correspond to regulated unit values expressed in pesos per kilowatt-hour (kWh) and do not represent net revenues of the trust, nor do they consider operational adjustments, technical losses, regulatory incentives, or other applicable concepts pursuant to the current regulation.

<sup>1</sup> Transmission fees for injection apply to Generators and Storage Entities for the injection of electricity into the National Transmission Network (NTN), depending on the voltage level used, in accordance with the Settlements Manual (*Manual de Liquidaciones*), as amended or replaced.

<sup>2</sup> Transmission fees for withdrawal apply to Load-Serving Entities and Storage Entities for the withdrawal of electricity from the NTN, depending on the voltage level used, in accordance with the Settlements Manual, as amended or replaced.
